

Mosaik Credit Union CEO Announces Retirement After 40 Years of Service

Nova Scotia — February 12, 2026 — After more than four decades of service in the credit union system across Germany, British Columbia, and Nova Scotia, Georg Oberprieler, Chief Executive Officer of Mosaik Credit Union, has announced his retirement, effective January 23, 2026. His decision comes earlier than anticipated due to a recent diagnosis of Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS).

Georg began his career as an apprentice in Germany and went on to hold nearly every position in a financial institution — from Teller, Investment Advisor, and Lender, to Branch Manager, Regional Manager, and ultimately, CEO. This journey gave him a deep understanding of both the operational and human side of the credit union movement, as well as a lifelong commitment to cooperative values.

In Canada, Georg built his career in both British Columbia and Nova Scotia. Most notably, he was the driving force behind the merger of New Ross Credit Union, Community Credit Union and Victory Credit Union, which paved the way for the creation of Mosaik Credit Union in January 2025. “To see Mosaik officially come to life has been one of the proudest moments of my career,” said Georg. “It has a bright future ahead, and I am grateful to have been able to help lay the foundation and now hand it over to a strong leadership team.”

Reflecting on his career, he added, “It has been the privilege of my life to work alongside such dedicated colleagues, boards of directors, and partners, and to serve the members who are at the heart of the credit union movement. While my time as CEO has come to an end sooner than I expected, I am deeply proud of what we have accomplished together.”

Beyond his professional achievements, Georg is using this moment to bring awareness to ALS, a rare and devastating neurological disease. “By sharing my journey, I hope to raise awareness of ALS and support efforts to find treatments and, ultimately, a cure,” he said.

The Board of Directors of Mosaik Credit Union express gratitude for Georg’s decades of dedication and leadership. “His vision and commitment have shaped Mosaik into the strong, member-focused organization it is today. We thank him for his service and wish him and his family strength and peace in the days ahead,” said Daniel Roper, Chair of the Board of Directors.
